INTENDED USE


The device is intended for storage of CQ Medical medical devices.

MOUNTING STORAGE RACK

PRIOR TO USE: •

- If desired, storage rack may be configured to have hinge on right hand side. See section "Changing Hinge Orientation" for instructions.
- Ensure adequate space for operation of hinge arms (See figure 1).
- Suggested height will provide approximately 4" of clearance off floor when hanging longest extension on rack.

CONCRETE WALL

NOTE: Tools Required: 5/16" masonry drill bit, 3/16" masonry drill bit, 1/2" socket, 9/64 Hex wrench, hammer and #3 phillips screw driver (not provided).

- 1. Drill four (4) 5/16" diameter pilot holes into concrete wall at locations specified. (See figure 1).
- Support storage rack and align holes in wall plate with drilled pilot holes.
- 3. Mount storage rack to wall using four (4) concrete anchors (provided).
- Ensure storage device is securely attached to wall.

WOOD STUD WALL

NOTE: •


- Storage rack must be mounted onto 16" on-center studs.
- Tools Required: 15/64" drill bit, 1/8" drill bit, 1/2" socket, 9/64 Hex wrench and #3 phillips screw driver (not provided).
- 1. Drill four (4) 15/64" diameter pilot holes into wall studs at locations specified. (See figure 1).
- 2. Mount storage rack to wall using four (4) lag screws (provided).
- Ensure storage device is securely attached to wall.

STEEL STUD WALL


NOTE:

- · Storage rack must be mounted onto 16" on-center studs.
- Tools Required: 1/2" drill bit, 1/8" drill bit, 3/16 Hex wrench, 9/64 Hex wrench and #3 phillips screw driver (not provided).
- 1. Drill four (4) 1/2" diameter pilot holes into wall studs at locations specified. (See figure 1).
- Install toggle anchors:


Hold metal channel flat alongside plastic straps, slide channel through pilot hole.



Hold ends of straps between thumb and forefinger, pull until channel rests flush behind wall. Strap ends
will be even lengths when channel is flush. Slide plastic cap along straps into pilot hole until flange of cap
is flush with wall.




Snap off straps flush with flange of cap and discard.



- 3. Mount storage rack to wall using four (4) 1/4-20 screws and washers (provided).
- 4. Ensure storage device is securely attached to wall.


INSTALLING BOLT COVERS AND WALL GUARDS

1. Use two (2) #8 cap screws (provided) to secure bolt covers over wall plate fasteners (4).



NOTE: Wall guards protect Varian Extension (MTIL6667) and wall from damage.


Drill two (2) 1/8" diameter pilot holes for wood stud and steel stud walls (3/16" for concrete walls) into wall at locations specified.




- 3. Insert two (2) #14 screws thru top hole of wall guards into pilot holes.
- 4. Drill two (2) pilot holes in bottom hole location and insert two (2) remaining #14 screws.

USING STORAGE RACK

NOTE: Each extension will hang on storage rack hooks using round slots in backside of junction.



NOTE: To avoid damage, hang Varian Extension (MTIL6667) behind other extensions.




1. Center extension forks between two outer stops and hang on hooks.


CHANGING HINGE ORIENTATION (OPTIONAL)

NOTE: Tools Required: 9/64, 3/16, 5/32 Hex wrenches and #3 phillips screw driver (not provided).


1. Remove outer stops (8) and hooks (8) from crossbars and wall plate. Re-attach to opposite side.




2. Remove rubber (2) bumpers, re-attach to opposite side.




3. Remove gussets (6) from crossbars, set aside crossbars and gussets.



Remove full hinge assembly, re-attach to opposite side.



Re-attach crossbars and gussets.
